**Other Matters**

(i)Clerk advised the Parish Council of the update regarding Wadley Plump Grassed area improvements, and advised improvements will be installed during school holidays.

(ii)The Parish Council received the update relating to access at Beverley Road and requested Clerk advise the ERYC the access us being used on a regular basis. People are using this with the four wheeled drive vehicles.

(iii)The Parish Council received the update regarding Stonepit Road signage. Clerk advised the ERYC had advised they will not proceed in placing North & South Road signed to the Road. The Parish Council requested Clerk contact the emergency services to establish if they have the correct North and South signage on their system.

(iv)The Parish Council received letter/email regarding Swinescaife quarry and the usage of Motorbikes accessing via the plantation & received update regarding signage at Little Wold Lane Plantation. It was noted the ERYC Countryside department will install signage. The Parish Council request Clerk Publish to ERYC Anti Social Behaviour weblink and publish the number to complain on 101.

(v)The Parish Council considered supporting the NHS Healthcheck bus and requested Clerk advise the ERYC of their support for the project and suggest the Carpark at Wadley Plump/Near Playpark be used.

(vi)The Parish Council received the update relating to Footpath/Cycle track at A1034 to Rudstone Walk and noted the ERYC were reluctant to arrange a meeting at this point, however, were looking into a footpath extension as a cycle path/Footpath would not be within budgets. Clerk advised she would continue to notify the Parish Council of

updates. The Parish Council requested the Ward Councillor support the suggestion and make contact with the relevant party at the ERYC as South Cave has not been allocated funding for 2015/16.

(vii)The Parish Council noted the information relating to the Community Partnership Group meetings and was advised the Meeting had been suspended for the time being, due to the question being raised regarding value for money.

(viii)The Parish Council noted the changes to Planning Notifications received from ERYC to Electronic and the discontinuation of Paper Planning Applications being submitted. The Parish Council requested the Clerk contact the ERYC and highlight the disappointment in the withdrawal of the Paper Plans. Proposed Cllr L Turner, Seconded Cllr Kelly, All in favour.
