Proposal: Erection of a new stable block for horses within an existing grazing paddock

Location: Land East Of Jasmine Common Road South Cave East Riding Of Yorkshire HU15 2EA

Applicant: Mrs Maria Burke

Application type: Full Planning Permission

Cllr Barnett proposed the Parish Council recommended Refusal of the application due to the impact of the visual amenity of the area. The usual construction of a stable block would be a semi permanent timber structure and this Block built permanent structure would have a detrimental impact on this rural setting. The proposed construction is within very close proximity to neighbouring properties and would have a detrimental impact on the neighbouring property. Seconded Cllr Munby, Vote 8 in favour, 1 abstention
