Following a number of complaints relating to the safety of the zebra crossing located at Market Place, South Cave. The Parish Council requested the installation of a light controlled crossing. A survey of the crossing was conducted by the East Riding of Yorkshire Council, and they have declined the request stating:

'Based on the survey and enumerators observations the Council is satisfied that the zebra crossing fulfils current crossing demand in relation to traffic flow. Pedestrians did not experience difficulty in asserting precedence over traffic over and above what is normally experienced at other sites. There are certain advantages of a zebra crossing over a light controlled crossing in as far as the pedestrians is more aware of approaching traffic rather than assuming the driver has seen the traffic signal and will stop which is not always the case. Light controlled crossings are not necessarily safer as the accident rate at both is relatively the same.'

'The Council therefore cannot justify converting the existing zebra crossing to a light controlled crossing but thanks you for your comments'
